The men slept well at night. A false alarm was created before night by some boys shooting hogs. The men were drawn up in line of battle and were ready to go back to their quarters, which they did. Tuesday, June 7-- Traveled seventeen miles and made four bridges, the rebels having destroyed those formerly used. Passed through Woodstock and Edinburg and several smaller towns and encamped at Mt. Jackson for the night. The men were considerably fatigued. Captain Mochelle and five privates of the 15th New York cavalry were captured from our...
